Gretchen Williams of Mercer Human Resource Consulting provided an in-depth overview of the Financial and Design implications of the new Act. Gretchen's presentation looked at many aspects of the new Act including Funding targets as well as minimum Contribution requirements for Defined benefit programs.

The Session will wrap up with a presentation from Barbara Wallace, President and CEO of the Virginia Business Coalition on Health. Barbara will provide a discussion on health care analytical tools being used in the Health & Welfare marketplace.
